Your operation, Prince and Princess Investment Inc. located at 8085 W AIRPORT BLVD, HOUSTON, TX 77071-3034, was recently investigated because of a report concerning a possible deficiency of the minimum standard rules or another law.

Specifically, the report states the following that led to this investigation:

A child in care received marker ink on his buttocks and rectum due to the actions of another child in care.

The Child Care Regulation (CCR) department of the Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) has evaluated applicable administrative rules, minimum standard rules, and other laws and made the following findings:

<p>746.1201(4) AP Responsibilities of Employees and Caregivers -Ensure No Child Abused, Neglected, or Exploited</p>	<p>An administrative penalty will be recommended as a result of this citation, per HRC §42.078</p> <p>The operation was informed that all parents must be notified of the citation using Form 7266, Notification of Abuse/Neglect/Exploitation Deficiency, a copy was sent via email.</p> <p>Supervision is basic to the prevention of harm. Parents have an understanding that caregivers will supervise their children in their absence. Adults who are attentive and who understand young children’s behaviors are in the best position to safeguard their well- being.</p> <p>Child-care centers can also establish an understanding with parents regarding who (when the parent and when the center) is responsible for the child while the parent and the child are both on the premises. These understandings could be laid out in the enrollment agreement.</p>

This letter serves as notification of the above-listed finding(s) with a Notification Date of 05/04/2022. As such, the list may include findings for which you received prior notification. For any finding listed above with an earlier notification date, your 15-day timeframe for requesting an administrative review of that finding began when you first received notification of that finding. If the time period to request an administrative review of a finding has expired, you may no longer request an administrative review of that finding.

You must notify the parent/guardian of each child enrolled in your facility of the violation of the Abuse/Neglect minimum standard(s) listed above. You must use Form 7266 posted on the HHS website to notify each parent/guardian by no later than 05/09/2022.

If CCR conducted an inspection as part of this investigation, you received an inspection report form.

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Your operation is responsible for maintaining compliance with relevant minimum standards, administrative rules, and statutes on an ongoing basis. CCR may take an enforcement action for a repetition or pattern of deficiencies or for any other reason listed in 26 Texas Administrative Code §745.8605.

This notice must be posted next to your most recent CCR inspection letter or form.
