THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

COUNT ONE
Distribution of Fentanyl Causing Death
[21 U.S.C. § 841(a)(1)]

On or about September 23, 2021, in the Western District of Texas, Defendant,

JUAN IGNACIO SORIA GAMEZ,

knowingly and intentionally distributed a mixture and substance that contained a detectable amount of fentanyl, a Schedule II controlled substance, and the use of such substance resulted in death and serious bodily injury to T. R., a person whose full identity is known to the grand jury.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C).

COUNT TWO
Distribution of Fentanyl
[21 U.S.C. § 841(a)(1)]

On or about February 22, 2022, in the Western District of Texas, Defendant,

JUAN IGNACIO SORIA GAMEZ,

knowingly and intentionally distributed a mixture and substance that contained a detectable amount of fentanyl, a Schedule II controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a) and 841(b)(1)(C).

COUNT THREE
