### SEARCH WARRANT

- e. Blood in the form of droplets, smears, and pools and other residue constituting evidence of bleeding injuries or other violent trauma, including if necessary for collection and seizure, the substance or surface on which said blood evidence is found.
- f. Telephones, computers, recording devices, cameras, and/or any other media in which digital data may be stored.
- g. Maps, binoculars, and/or any other items that would be indicative of surveillance


If you find the above described items, you are to seize that property and dispose of the items as provided by law.

**AFFIDAVIT FOR SEARCH WARRANT**

**THE STATE OF TEXAS  
COUNTY OF UVALDE**

**BEFORE ME, THE UNDERSIGNED AUTHORITY PERSONALLY APPEARED THE AFFIANT HEREIN, A PEACE OFFICER UNDER THE LAWS OF TEXAS, WHO BEING DULY SWORN, ON OATH MADE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENTS:**

My name is [REDACTED], I am a commissioned peace officer by the Texas Department of Public Safety, Texas Rangers Division.

Affiant [REDACTED] is a certified Master Peace Officer in the State of Texas with continuous 18 plus years of law enforcement service. Affiant is employed by the Texas Department of Public Safety and is currently appointed to the Texas Rangers Division. Affiant's duties with the Texas Rangers involve several areas of criminal investigations within law enforcement to include local crime, aggravated assault, sexual assault, theft, theft by a public servant, robbery, fugitive arrests, manslaughter, murder as well as conducting criminal investigations for the La Salle County Sheriff, Zavala County Sheriff and the Crystal City Police Department Chief of Police. Prior to being appointed to the Texas Rangers, Affiant was assigned to the Texas Department of Public Safety, Criminal Investigations Division as a Special Agent to investigate organized crime to include illegal narcotics, weapons, and bulk cash smuggling for 6 plus years, (11/01/2014 to 12/01/2020).

Affiant, has received specialized training on criminal patrol, drug interdiction tactics, organized drug trafficking, interview and interrogation tactics, advanced criminal investigations, and advanced 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup> Amendment training as early as 2003. Affiant has conducted investigations on manslaughter, sexual assaults, aggravated assaults, aggravated robbery, drug trafficking organizations and violent Texas gangs which resulted in Affiant writing and executing multiple search warrants at locations concealing evidence, illegal narcotics, weapons to include the seizure of bulk cash in U.S. currency and possession of child pornography within the State of Texas. Affiant has conducted interviews and interrogations of numerous suspects to further his understanding during criminal investigations which led to felony arrests, State and Federal indictments and convictions.

1. There is in Uvalde County, Texas, a suspected vehicle and property described as and located as follows: Gray in color, 2008, Ford, F-150, V.I.N. [REDACTED] [REDACTED], Texas Registration ([REDACTED]). Said Ford is presently located directly behind the property of Robb Elementary School, 715 Old Carrizo Springs Road, Uvalde, Texas 78801. There is at said place, stated suspected item constituting evidence of a criminal offense or constituting evidence tending to show that a particular person committed a criminal offense:
2. Said suspected item is in charge of and controlled by each of the following persons:

Texas Department of Public Safety, Texas Ranger Division, Eagle Pass, Maverick County, Texas by Texas Ranger [REDACTED].

3. It is the belief of the Affiant, and he hereby charges and accuses, that: Said suspected item is the following: **Gray in color, 2008, Ford, F-150, V.I.N. [REDACTED], Texas Registration (FN [REDACTED])** used by and abandoned by **Suspect: Salvador Rolando Ramos, H/M, DOB: 05/16/2004** on May 24, 2022, in connection with: **Capital Murder: Penal Code 19.03.**

4. Affiant has probable cause for said belief by reason of the following facts:

On 05/24/2022, Affiant was contacted by Texas Department of Public Safety, Texas Ranger Lieutenant [REDACTED] who briefed Affiant regarding an active shooter and multiple casualties in the Uvalde County area.

On 05/24/2022, Affiant traveled to Robb Elementary School located at 715 Old Carrizo Road, Uvalde, Texas 78801. Upon arrival, Affiant was briefed by lead investigator, Company "D" Texas Ranger [REDACTED]. Ranger [REDACTED] stated the Suspect: Salvador Rolando Ramos, DOB: 05/16/2004, Hispanic, Male, arrived at the rear property of Robb Elementary School, 715 Old Carrizo Springs Road, Uvalde, Texas 78801 while operating a Gray in color, 2008, Ford, Texas Registration [REDACTED]. Ramos exited the Ford, while armed with a long rifle and began shooting towards the buildings of Robb Elementary School. Ramos abandoned the Ford and continued to advance towards the interior of Robb Elementary School and gained access inside the school. While inside the school, Ramos fatally shot multiple students and injured several others.

On 05/24/2022, I was briefed by Company "F" Texas Ranger [REDACTED] regarding two male witnesses which were identified by Ranger [REDACTED] as [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. According to Ranger [REDACTED], he learned that the two male witnesses observed a male subject dressed completely in black with long shoulder length black hair standing by the passenger side of the Ford, Texas ([REDACTED]). According to Ranger [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] walked towards the subject after he had crashed into a ditch behind the elementary school. As [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] approached the male subject, the male subject was holding a long rifle and proceeded to load the rifle with a magazine. According to Ranger [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] retreated towards the Hillcrest Memorial Funeral Home located at 424 Geraldine St., Uvalde, Texas when the male subject began to fire multiple gunshots in their direction. According to Ranger [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] witnessed the male subject, approach the school and begin shooting towards the buildings.

On 05/24/2022, Affiant was briefed by Company "D" Texas Ranger [REDACTED] who responded to the Robb Elementary School and entered the mentioned property. According to Ranger [REDACTED], local, state, and federal law enforcement officers gained access into the Robb Elementary School in an attempt to locate Ramos. According to Ranger [REDACTED] law enforcement officers encountered multiple injured students who had suffered apparent gunshot wounds as well as multiple casualties throughout the hallways and classrooms. According to Ranger [REDACTED] law enforcement officers encountered Ramos inside one of the classrooms. Ramos fired multiple gunshots towards their direction. Law enforcement officers

returned gunfire and fatally shot Ramos. Among Ramos' belongings, a, Black in color, Apple, I-Phone, 13 Pro-Max was located next to Ramos body. Upon further observation, Ramos was wearing all black clothing and had long black hair which matched description previously obtained from [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]

**5. Affiant believes based on training and experience, the following items and/or evidence could be located inside said vehicle:**

- a. Shoe impressions.
- b. Fingerprints.
- c. Receipts from purchases made on or after 05/24/2022 and or showing travel in the Uvalde County, Texas area.
- d. Other documentation relating to Salvador Rolando Ramos.
- e. Blood in the form of droplets, smears, and pools and other residue constituting evidence of bleeding injuries or other violent trauma, including if necessary for collection and seizure, the substance or surface on which said blood evidence is found.
- f. Telephones, computers, recording devices, cameras, and/or any other media in which digital data may be stored.
- g. Maps, binoculars, and/or any other items that would be indicative of surveillance


